

Total Coliform Rule (RTCR) Failure to Report Monitoring Events to the
State that are Not Related to E. coli-positive Sample Results – Template 3-5
And Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
EL SAUZ WSC PWS 2140028.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During SEPT 2022, we did not monitor or test for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

Our system failed to collect every required coliform sample. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation.

What should I do? There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

What is being done? Corrective action: In order to return to compliance, we had to collect several monthly distribution samples and those were collected on 10/17/2022 and we were no longer in violation.

EL SAUZ WSC (2140028) has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.
